The ETC is a 2½ day trauma simulator based course for doctors and is endorsed by the *European Resuscitation Council (ERC)*, *European Society of Trauma Surgeons (ESTES)*, *European Society of Anaesthesiologists (ESA)* and the *European Society of Emergency Medicine (EuSEM)*.

The course is suitable for **Surgeons, Anaesthetists and Emergency Physicians** expected to actively lead and / or participate in a trauma team.
